### National 3 Peaks Challenge for Burundi.

Over the May Bank Holiday 25 people mainly from Beaconsfield took on the challenge to climb the tallest mountains in England Scotland & Wales in 48 hours. 21 managed all 3 in the time & the others also got close to achieving the target. Between them they have raised more than £22,000 for long term development work in Burundi through Food for the Hungry. Burundi is one of the poorest countries in the world with the highest level of stunting (The main measure used by the UN to assess poverty) amongst children under 5 (57%). That means the majority of the children will not develop to their physical and intellectual potential. Food for the Hungry's work has demonstrated that by walking with these communities & supporting them through a long term development program, stunting can be dramatically reduced. Although all the team found the challenge exhausting and painful on times, reflecting on the challenges within the Burundi communities which they were supporting provided all the motivation they needed. Thank you to all the people of Beaconsfield who sponsored the climbers, it was very much appreciated.
